The 28th Hong Kong Book Fair Opens Next Wednesday Record-breaking Exhibitor Numbers and Heavyweight Line-up

13 July 2017 – The 28th HKTDC Hong Kong Book Fair opens next Wednesday (19 July) at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (HKCEC) and will continue through 25 July. A record number of about 670 exhibitors from 36 countries and regions will present books on a wide range of topics and in various languages. Under this year's theme "Travel," the Book Fair will feature nine travel authors at the Art Gallery by showcasing the photos taken and souvenirs obtained from their journeys. Historian Jason Wordie will share his insights on Macau and its history.

Renowned authors from the Chinese mainland, France, Spain, the United Kingdom and the United States will take part in an array of events, including the World of Knowledge Seminar Series as well as the English Reading and Creative Writing Seminar Series.
