25 July 2017 – Five concurrent events organised by the Hong Kong Trade Development Council (HKTDC) will open on 17 August at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (HKCEC). These are the 28th Food Expo, the fourth Home Delights Expo, the second Beauty & Wellness Expo, the ninth Hong Kong International Tea Fair and the International Conference of the Modernization of Chinese Medicine & Health Products (ICMCM).
